One Degree More Bursary – Closing Date for applications 13th March 2020

Wiltshire Community Foundation offers grants to young people in Wiltshire and Swindon who need support with the costs of studying an undergraduate degree at university. The One Degree More bursary is £1,600 for each year of a course.

Who is eligible to apply – young people can apply for a university bursary if they:

- are under 25 years old
- have lived in Wiltshire or Swindon for at least 2 years
- you, your parents or guardians receive 2 means-tested benefits (2 elements of Universal Credit)
- are eligible for funding through Student Finance England
- are studying for your first undergraduate degree at a UK university or institution

Bursaries can be used towards:

- general living expenses
- course costs
- travel costs (excluding studying abroad)
- books and equipment

The 2018 Student Money Survey revealed that around 70% of students don't even apply for grants, bursaries or scholarships, believing that they aren't eligible, and yet, on average there are at least 10 scholarships at any one time which are open to all students. That means that everyone is eligible for something. It doesn't of course mean that everyone will get something, but you certainly will not if you don't apply.
