₫	Satisfactory Attendance	90% – 94%	Watch closely

XX	Concerned Attendance	75% – 84%	Extra help in place
\triangle	Severe Non-Attendance	Below 75%	Statutory steps taken



Trigger:

• Attendance of 95% or higher each term

What We Do:

- Ø Verbal praise in class & assemblies
- W Termly certificates presented
- Positive email home from the Form Tutor
- If Entry into prize draws and special rewards

△ Category 2: Satisfactory Attendance (90%–94%)

Trigger:

Termly attendance between 90% and 94%

What We Do:

- Some-to-one chat with the Form Tutor and email home
- Supportive letter from our Attendance Officer

Category 3: At-Risk Attendance (85%–89%)

Trigger:

Year-to-date attendance between 85% and 89%

What We Do:

- School Attendance Meeting to set SMART attendance targets
- School Attendance Meeting to create a documented action plan for the family and School.
- Weekly check-ins with Head of Year

Category 4: Concerned Attendance (75%–84%)

Trigger:

• Year-to-date attendance between 75% and 84%

What We Do:

- 🔓 School Attendance Meeting 2 with relevant staff at School e.g. SENCO/PP Lead
- School Attendance Meeting 2 where SMART targets & Action Plan reviewed and redefined.
- Weekly monitoring plus daily morning check-in with the Pastoral Team
- S Link with external agencies (e.g. CAMHS, WHMST, Spurgeons & The Family Hub)

⚠ Category 5: Severe Non-Attendance (Below 75%)

Trigger:

• Attendance below 75% at any point

What We Do:

- Refer to the Education Welfare Officer for statutory processes (e.g., Education Supervision Order)
- Issue formal warning letters with legal implications
- Liaise on court summons if no improvement
